Standards for 1:250,000 scale mapping using digital stereophotomaps, from aerial photography dated from 1963, December 2001, February 2002, or September-October 2002, combined analytically from ground photos captured using first-order global positioning system equipment. Topographic contours and elevations were derived using a digital terrain model from features derived from the North American Vertical Datum of 1985. Planerbers coordinates were based on the Pennsylvania State Plane
