Identifying and describing shapes

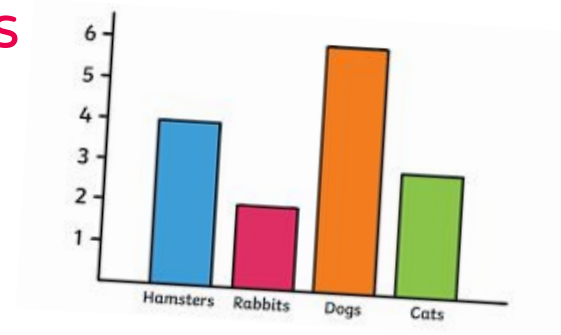

# Student Drop Off

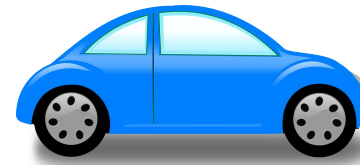
- Drop-Off is between 8:30-8:45am
