

Assessment Plan for College-Bound Students

There are two standardized assessments that colleges will accept as part of a student's application, the SAT and the ACT. Every college in the country will accept scores from **either** test. It is recommended that students take the practice test for each assessment. The Practice ACT is offered to 10th grade students in preparation for the ACT that will be taken during a student's junior or senior year, and the PSAT/NMSQT is offered to 11th grade students in preparation for the SAT, which students will take in their junior or senior year. The PSAT/NMSQT automatically screens 11th grade student for the National Merit Scholarship Program. The following assessment plan is offered and recommended for college-bound students.
